Measure C

Independent Citizen Oversight Committee (ICOC)

District Accountability:

The purpose of the ICOC is to ensure that parcel tax proceeds are spent as promised. Measure C was passed by District Votes on May 4, 2010. The purposes approved by the voters are specified in Lakeside Board Resolution #09/10-03, and the Measure C ballot language contained in the voter pamphlet.

The ICOC will monitor the expenditures of these funds by the District and will report on an annual basis to the Board and community on how these funds have been spent.

Procedure:

The ICOC will base its findings upon the report of the District's independent auditor and the ICOC report filed by the District CBO in accordance with California Government Code Sections 50075.1 and 50075.3. The report shall be presented at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees beginning in 2011.

ICOC Composition and Term:

The ICOC may consist of up to three members selected by a majority vote of the Board of Trustees at a regularly scheduled meeting. Members of the ICOC will be appointed to serve a term ending on the expiration or renewal of Measure C. Vacancies will be filled by the Board in the same manner.

Interested persons may apply for service on the ICOC by submitting a letter to the Board containing a statement of the reason for interest. Submitted letters should include the name, address and phone number of the interested person. Selection will be made at the Regular Board Meeting on September 15, 2010. Mail your letter to Lakeside Joint School District c/o Bob Chrisman, no later than September 8, 2010.
