1. Stay Informed:

SCHOOL BOARD OF TRUSTEES: The Board is the legally constituted body that assumes responsibility for the operation of the District as described in the California Education Code. SCHOOL SITE COUNCIL: The Site Council helps to design, budget, and evaluate the school's instructional program.
