LAKESIDE JOINT SCHOOL DISTRICT CONTIGUOUS PARCEL EXEMPTION INFORMATION SHEET

What is a contiguous parcel exemption?

The contiguous parcel exemption allows a property owner to combine adjacent parcels (i.e., parcels that share a common border) into one taxable unit for the purpose of the Parcel Tax. These parcels must be used solely for owner-occupied, single-family residential purposes, and must be held under identical ownership.

The consolidation of parcels applies only to the Lakeside Joint School District Measure C Parcel Tax and cannot be applied to any other tax. Upon approval of a contiguous parcel exemption, the parcel tax will apply only to the parcel which contains the principal residence.

How do I apply for an exemption?*

- A. Complete an application form. In addition to the application form you will need to provide verification of ownership, residency and additional documentation such as an official parcel map for properties which are contiguous. Please provide copies of the following documentation:
 - 1. Verification of Ownership:

A copy of your Property Tax Bill

2. Verification of Residency:
