

**LAKESIDE JOINT SCHOOL DISTRICT
SUPPLEMENTAL SECURITY INCOME FOR A DISABILITY EXEMPTION
INFORMATION SHEET**

How do I qualify for the SSI exemption?

You qualify for an exemption if:

You are receiving Supplemental Security Income for a disability, and you are the owner of a parcel within the Lakeside Joint school District, and that parcel is your principal residence. You must own and live in your home as of July 1 of the year the tax is due.

How do I apply for an exemption?*

- A. Complete an application form. In addition to the application form you will need to provide verification of ownership, residency and receipt of supplemental security income. Please provide copies of the following documentation:

1. Verification of Ownership:

A copy of your Property Tax Bill

2. Verification of Residency:

Drivers License or

Utility Bill or

Social Security Check

3. Verification of Supplemental Security Income:

A Benefits Verification Letter issued by the Social Security Administration

*Exemption requests must be verified annually. The Lakeside Joint School District will annually mail an Exemption Verification and Renewal Form to everyone receiving an exemption in the prior year.
