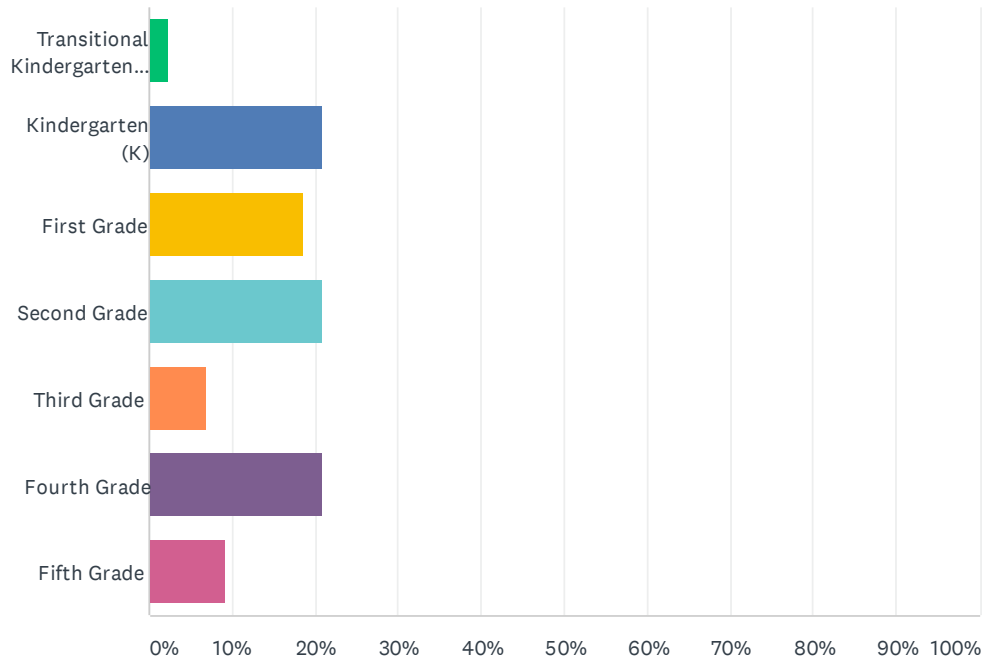


Q1 What grades will your child(ren) be entering in Fall 2020? Check all that apply.

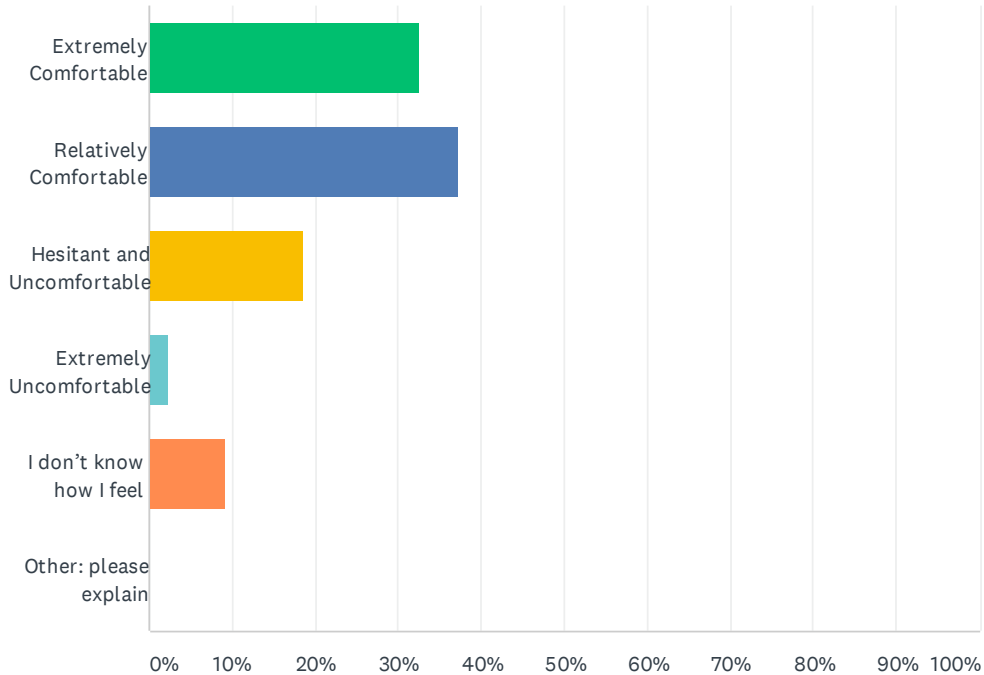

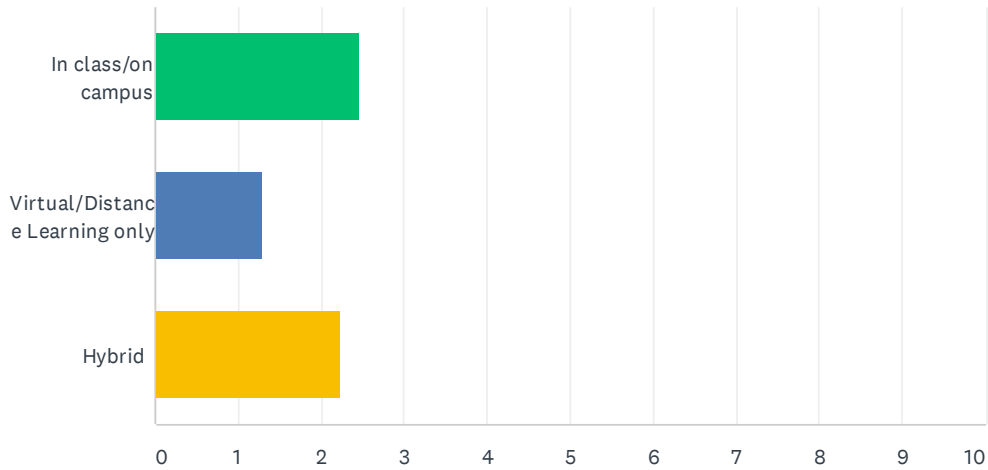

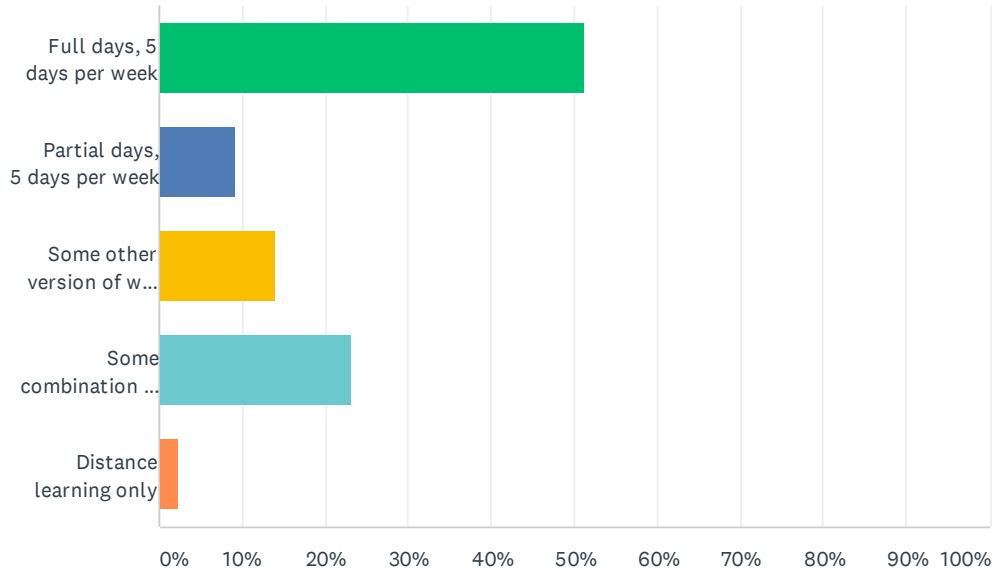

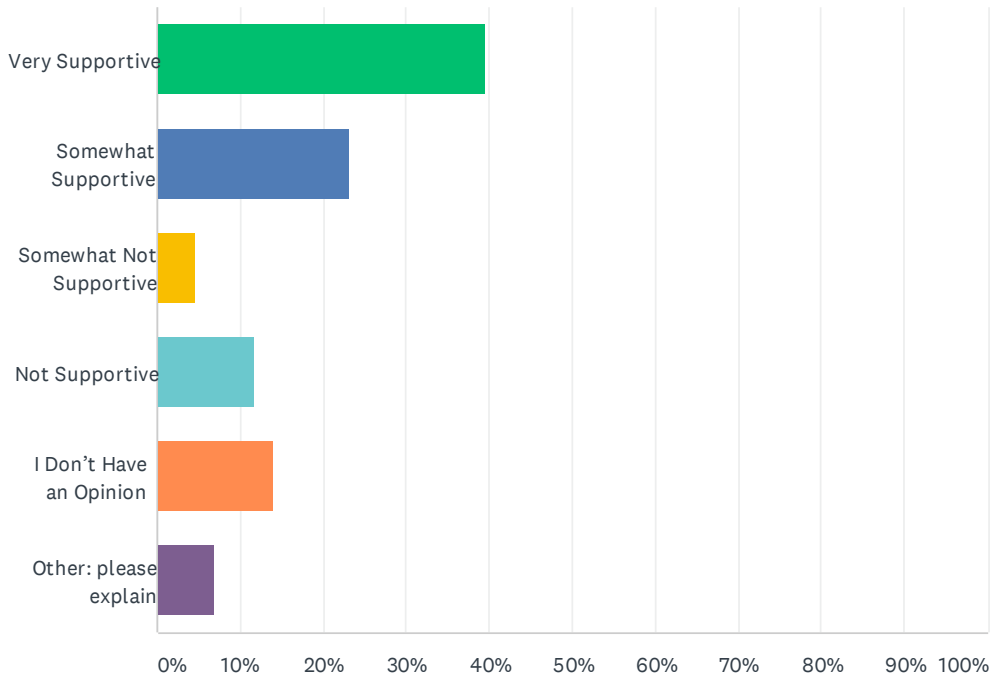

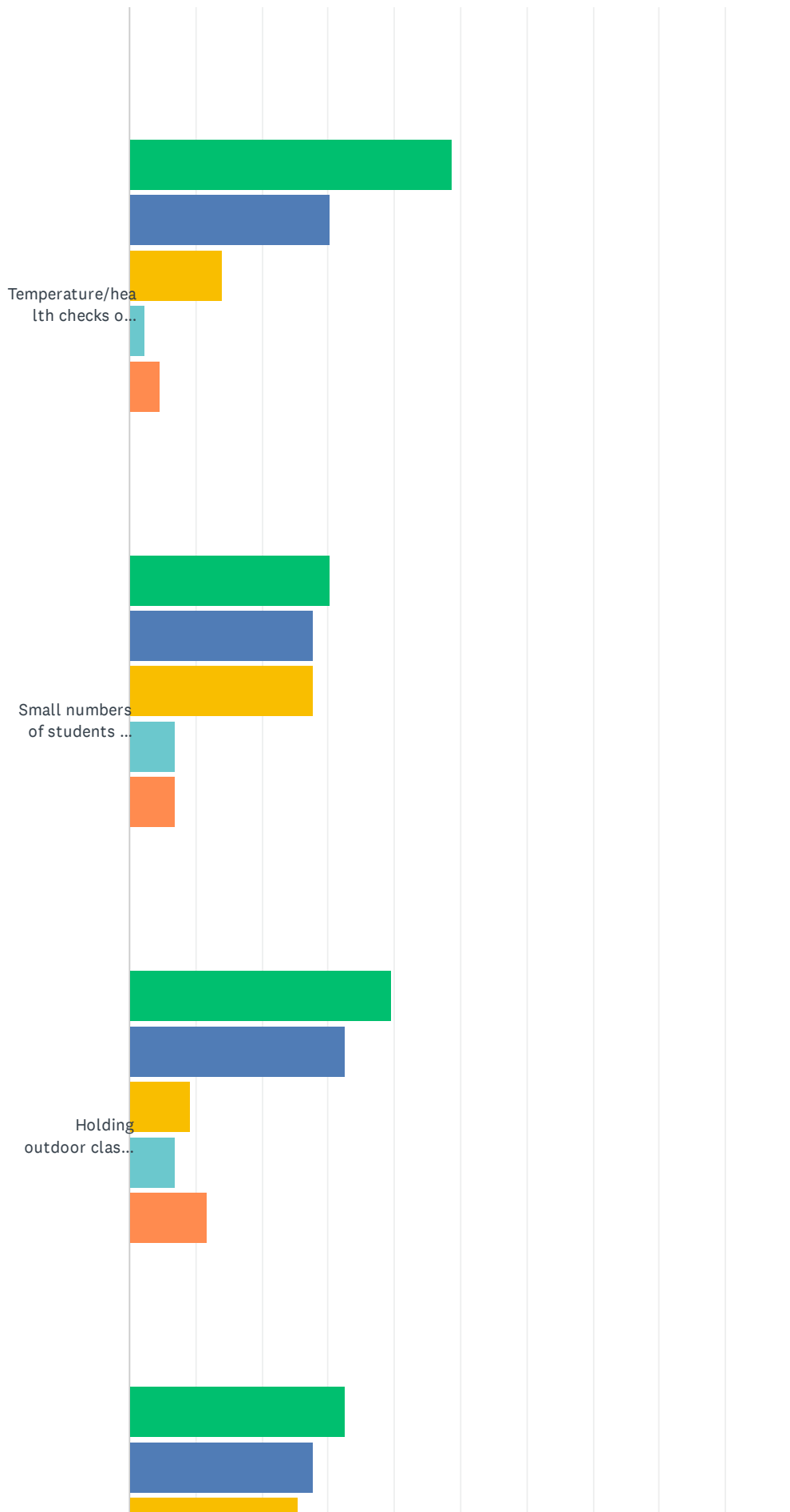

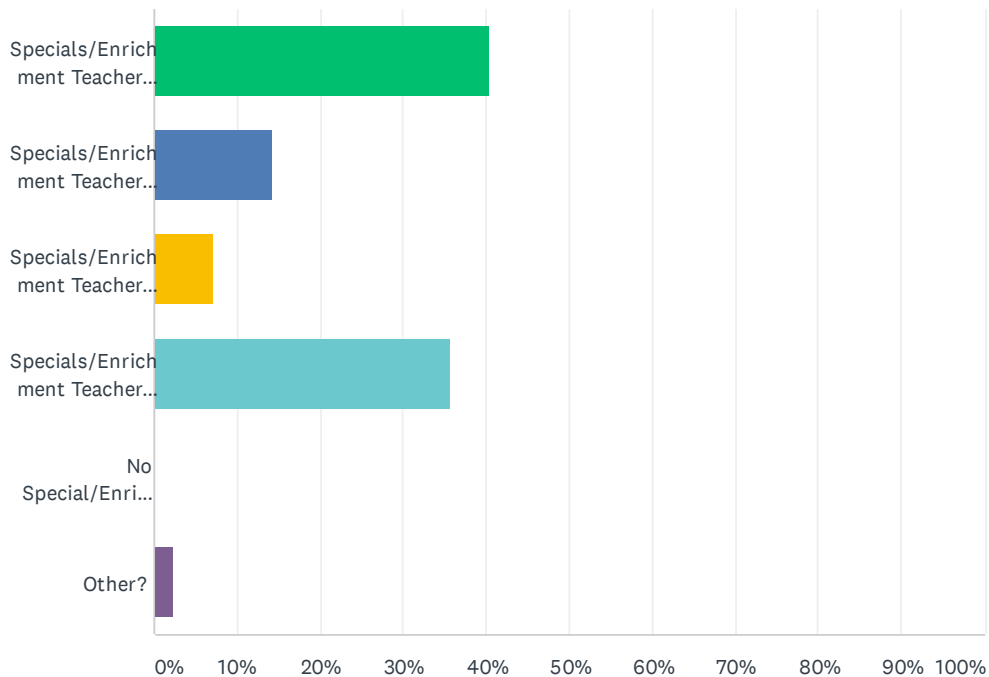

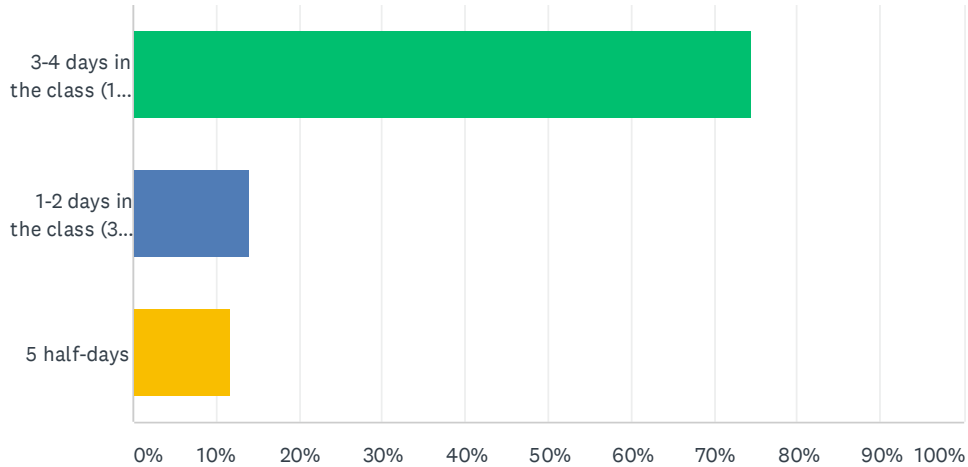

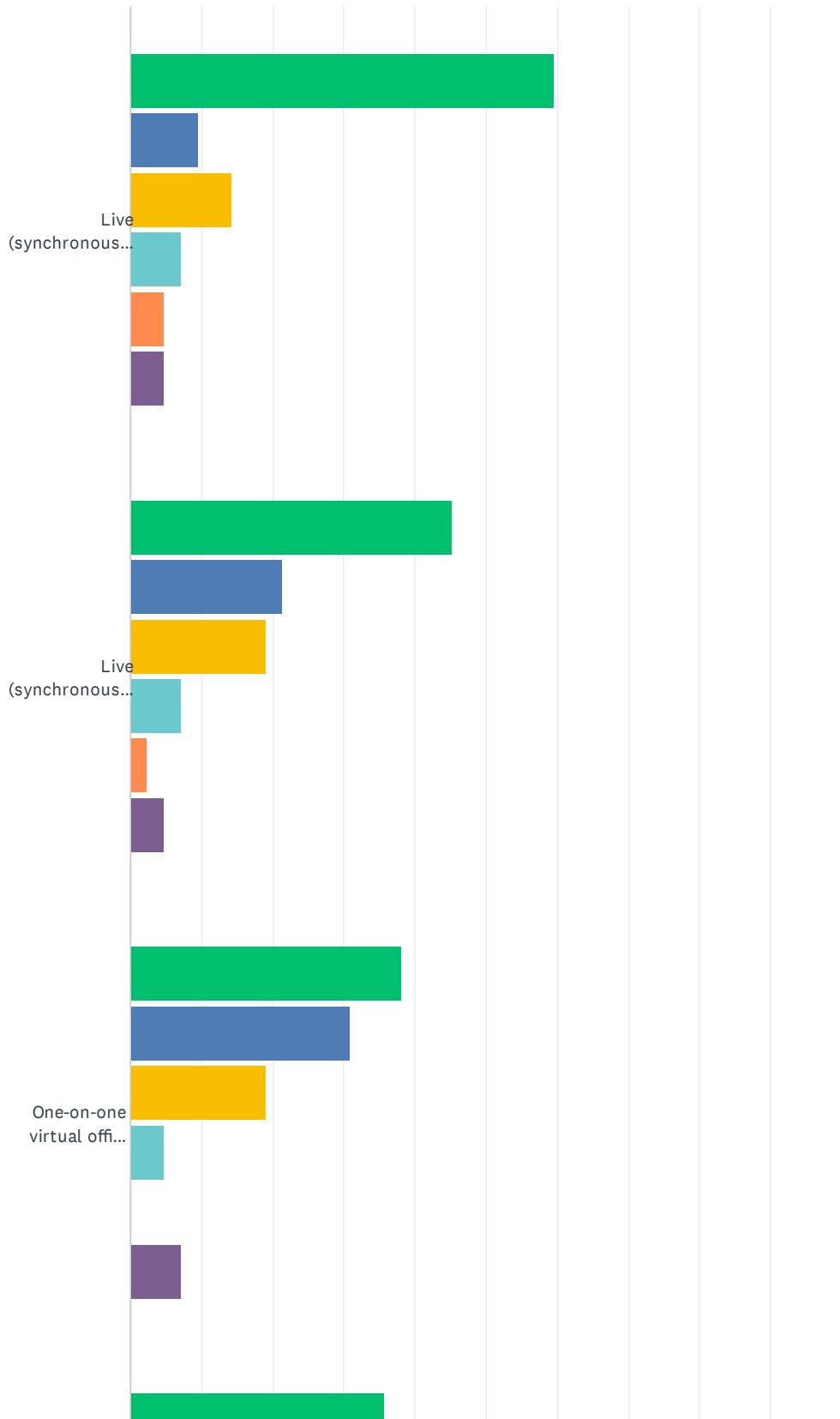

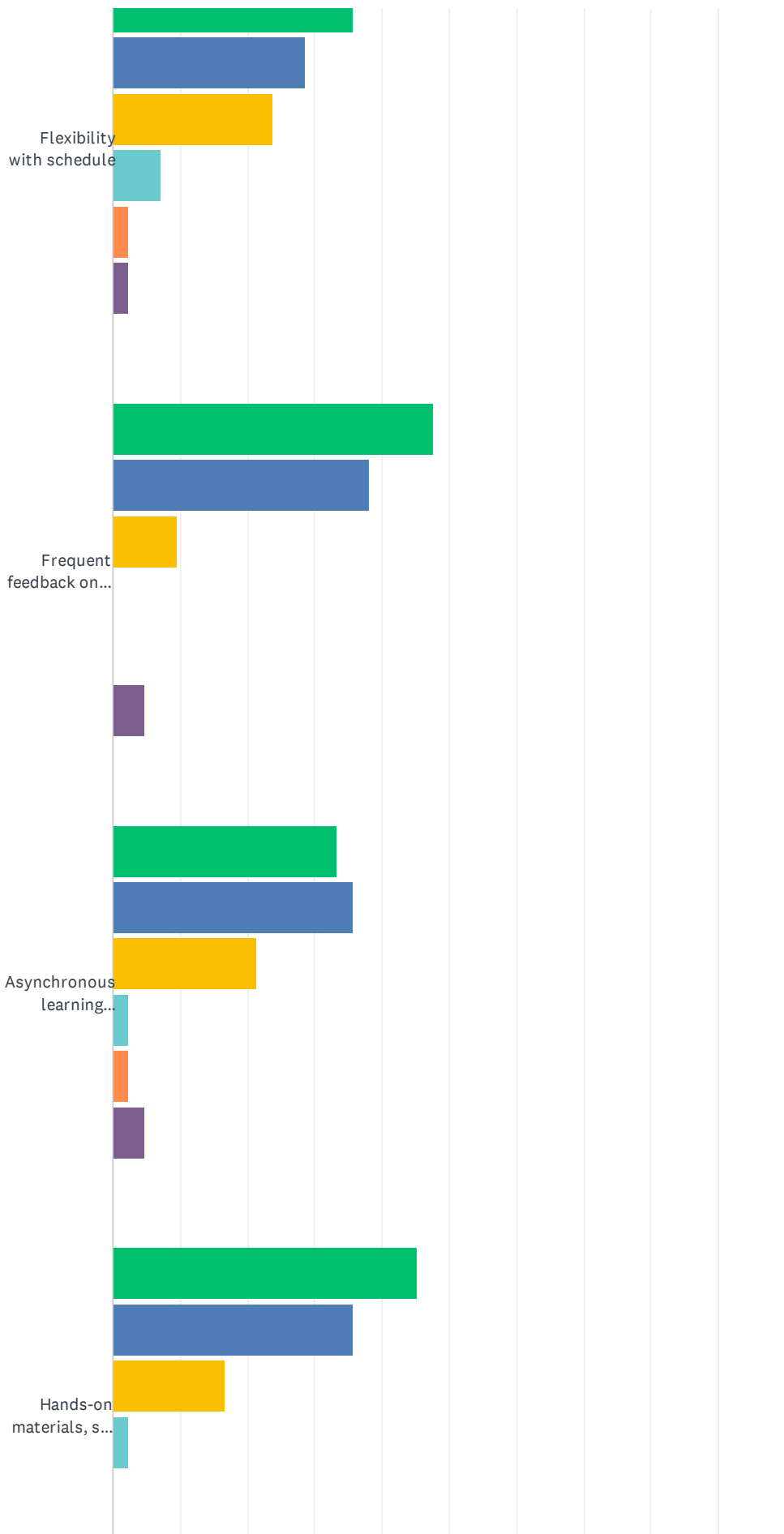

Q11 Should distance learning need to continue, how important are the following aspects of distance learning for Fall 2020?

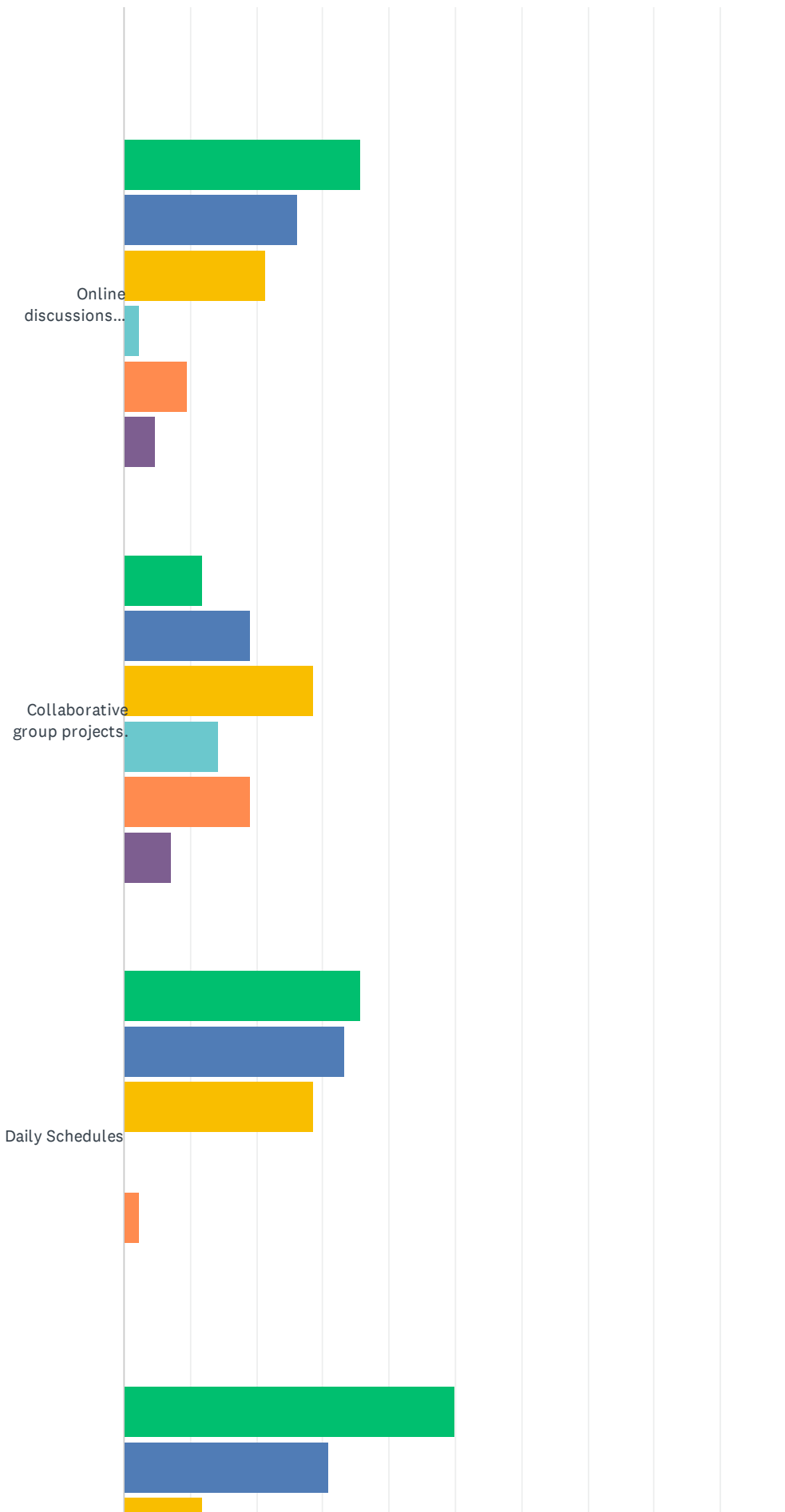
